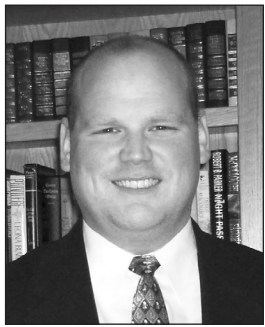


The first recorded history of the SCMB dates back to 1887 and it is believed to have been in existence before then. The band has taken many forms over the years, from playing while riding bicycles, G. Oliver Riggs led boys band in the 1920s, to its current concert band setup.

The band became full-time with rehearsals and concerts year-round in 1947. It has had many conductors over the years including Roger Barrett, Eugene Neri, Marv Pearson, Frank Herring, Kathleen Johnson, Richard Hansen, Bob Wig, Lowell Larson, Dave Haedt, Mel Hauck, Gordon Schlichting and Glen Tuomaala.

The SCMB has traveled to China, Mexico and will be going to Germany this summer. Members of the band have become members of the U.S. Navy Band, big bands of Tommy Dorsey and Gene Krupa, the Washington Redskins football band and many other professional groups. The band currently performs between 25 to 30 times a year including it's Summer Concert Series at Barden Park in St. Cloud and is led by Adam Tervola Hultberg.



Adam Tervola Hultberg has been the Conductor of the St. Cloud Municipal Band, since November 2009. Currently, Adam is a Music Department Graduate Assistant and Assistant Conductor at St. Cloud State University, after eight years of teaching middle and high school band at Detroit Lakes (MN) High School and Perham-Dent (MN) Public Schools. Ensembles under his leadership have earned superior ratings at the Minnesota State High School League contests.

Adam is also the President of the Minnesota Band Directors Association (MBDA). The organization is comprised of band directors representing all age levels and demographics throughout Minnesota. MBDA strives to provide young musicians with honor band/band festival opportunities and teachers with professional development workshops.

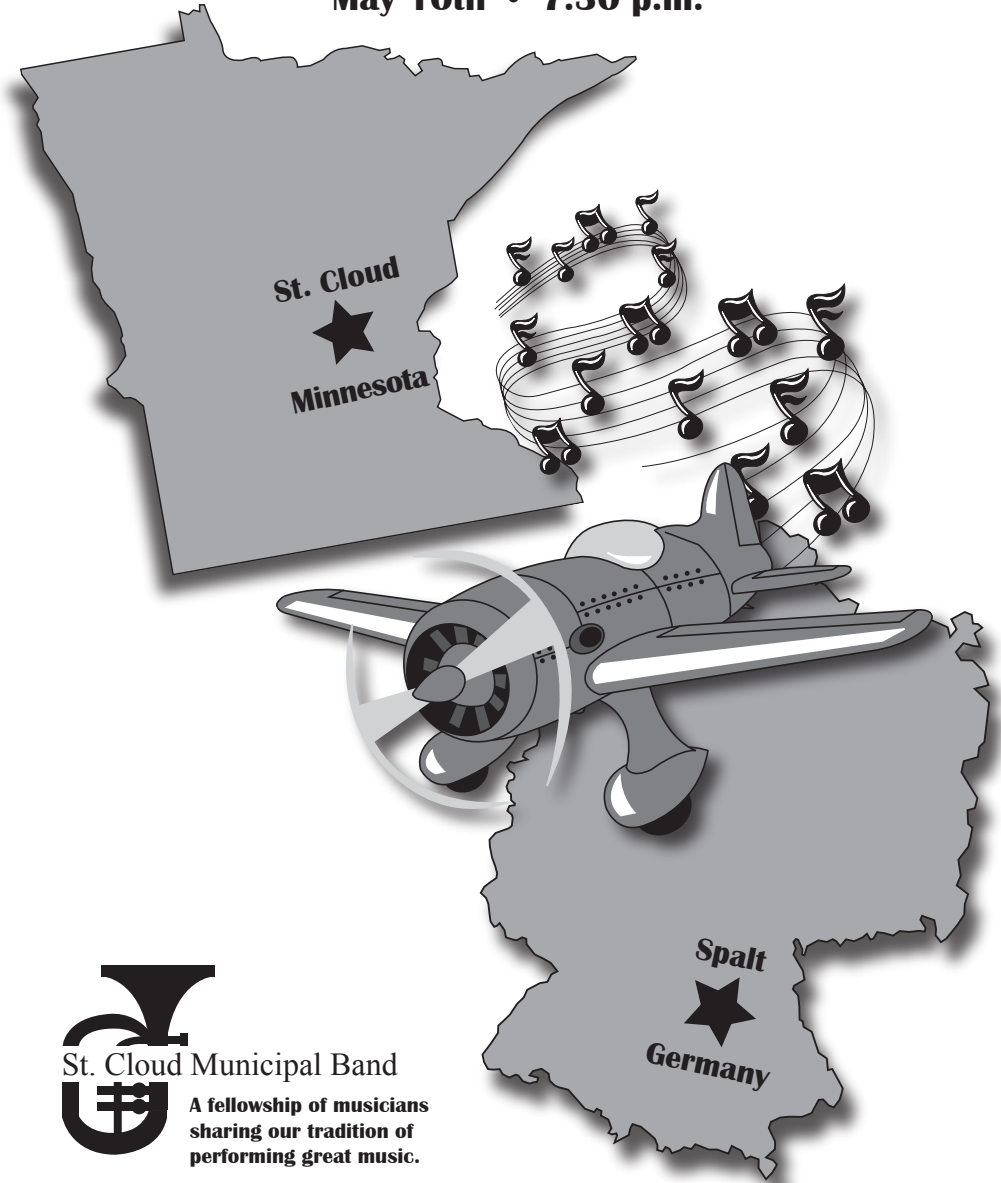
